#### Notes to the Income and Expenditure Statement

#### 1 General

Hanuman Carnival 2016 ("the event") is a charity event organised by Hong Kong Chinmaya Foundation Limited.

#### 2 Principal Accounting Policies

(a) Recognition of donations income

Donations income of the event is recognised when the donations money is received from donors.

(b) Recognition of expenditure

The expenditure of the event is recognised on an accrual basis.

#### 3 Taxation

As Hong Kong Chinmaya Foundation Limited is registered as a charitable organisation under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance, the event is exempted from Hong Kong profits tax.

#### 4 Purpose of Fund-raising

The purpose of raising fund was for Hanuman Carnival to promote Indian culture and enhance cross-cultural understanding. Surplus, if any, will be used for the organization expenses of the Hong Kong Chinmaya Foundation Limited.
